**What:** DEMCO presents a practical, hands-on seminar where participants learn and practice basic repairs for both hard and softbound books.

Emphasis is placed on becoming familiar with techniques and materials for economical in-house repair of materials that must be available for frequent use. Additionally, protective measures, which will extend the life of new materials, will be demonstrated and discussed. Long-term preservation of archival materials is not addressed. This workshop is useful for anyone involved in repair of library materials and participants will gain skills that can be shared with other staff or volunteers.

### Book repair workshop – *continued* from page 1

Wear and tear on books is inevitable, and most libraries perform minor repairs on their damaged materials. Despite staff members' good intentions, some materials and procedures used for repairing books can shorten the useful life of an item and make it hard to open and use. Done properly, book repair is an effective preservation strategy that can extend the useful life of a collection and reduce replacement and bidding costs.

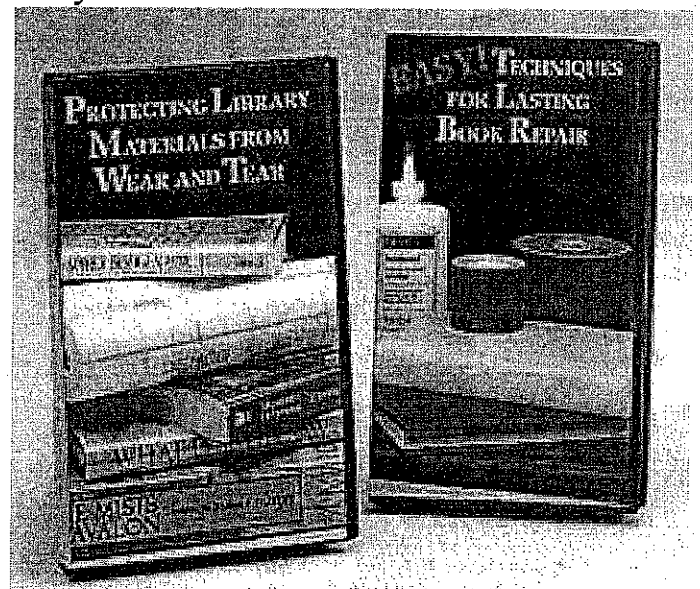
